? What is "original" work? Traditional concepts of originality are being challenged by AI-generated content.




Who or what is the author?

Content creation and language modeling tools that produce original work.




Predictive Al

Analytics and alerts that forecast student performance and needs.

Adaptive Al

Personalized learning experiences and tutoring based on student data.



Surveillance Al

Proctoring and behavior monitoring systems for assessment.



Assessment Redesign Strategies

Scaffold Al Use

Guide students through appropriate AI integration at each learning stage.

Process Over Product

Evaluate the journey of creation rather than just final deliverables.

Reflective Components

Include student analysis of how and why they used Al tools.

Oral Assessments

Incorporate presentations to verify understanding beyond written work.
